

Lesson 1: Greetings

Learning Goals

By the end of this lesson, students can:

- 1 Say "Hello" and "Hi".
- 2 Say "Goodbye" and "Bye".
- 3 Greet friends politely.
- 4 Use greetings in a short conversation. 

Let's Learn

- We say **Hello** or **Hi** when we meet someone.
- We say **Goodbye** or **Bye** when we leave.
- Always smile and be kind when you greet people.



New Words

Hello

Meaning: A polite word to greet someone.

Example: Hello, Emma!



Hi

Meaning: A friendly way to say hello.

Example: Hi, Tom!



Goodbye

Meaning: A polite word to say when you leave.

Example: Goodbye, Miss Lee.



Bye

Meaning: A short and friendly way to say goodbye.

Example: Bye! See you tomorrow!
